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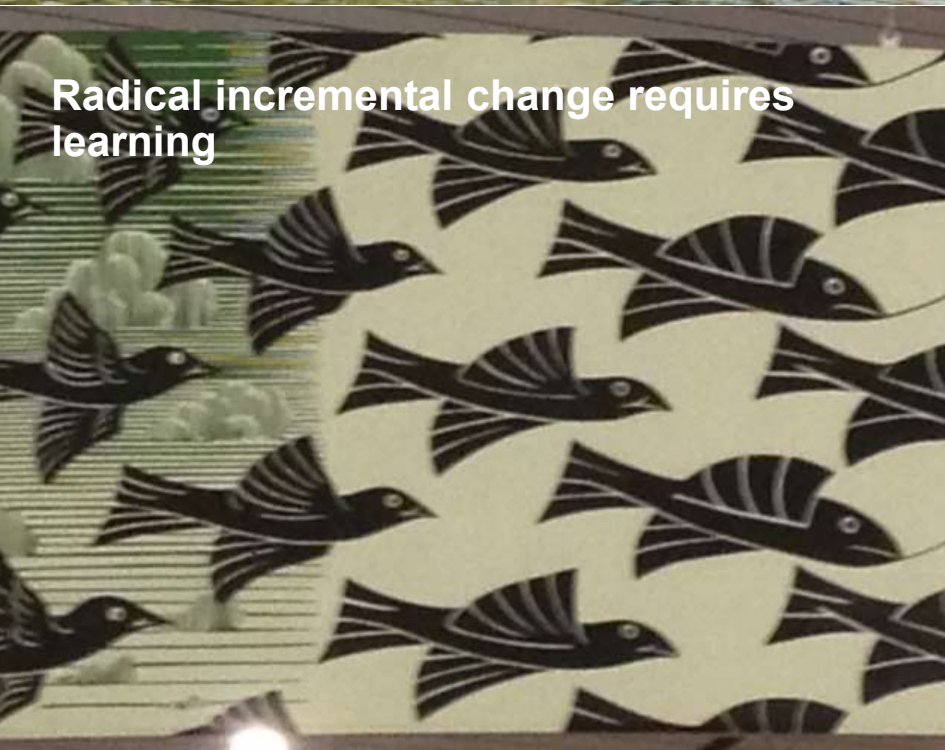

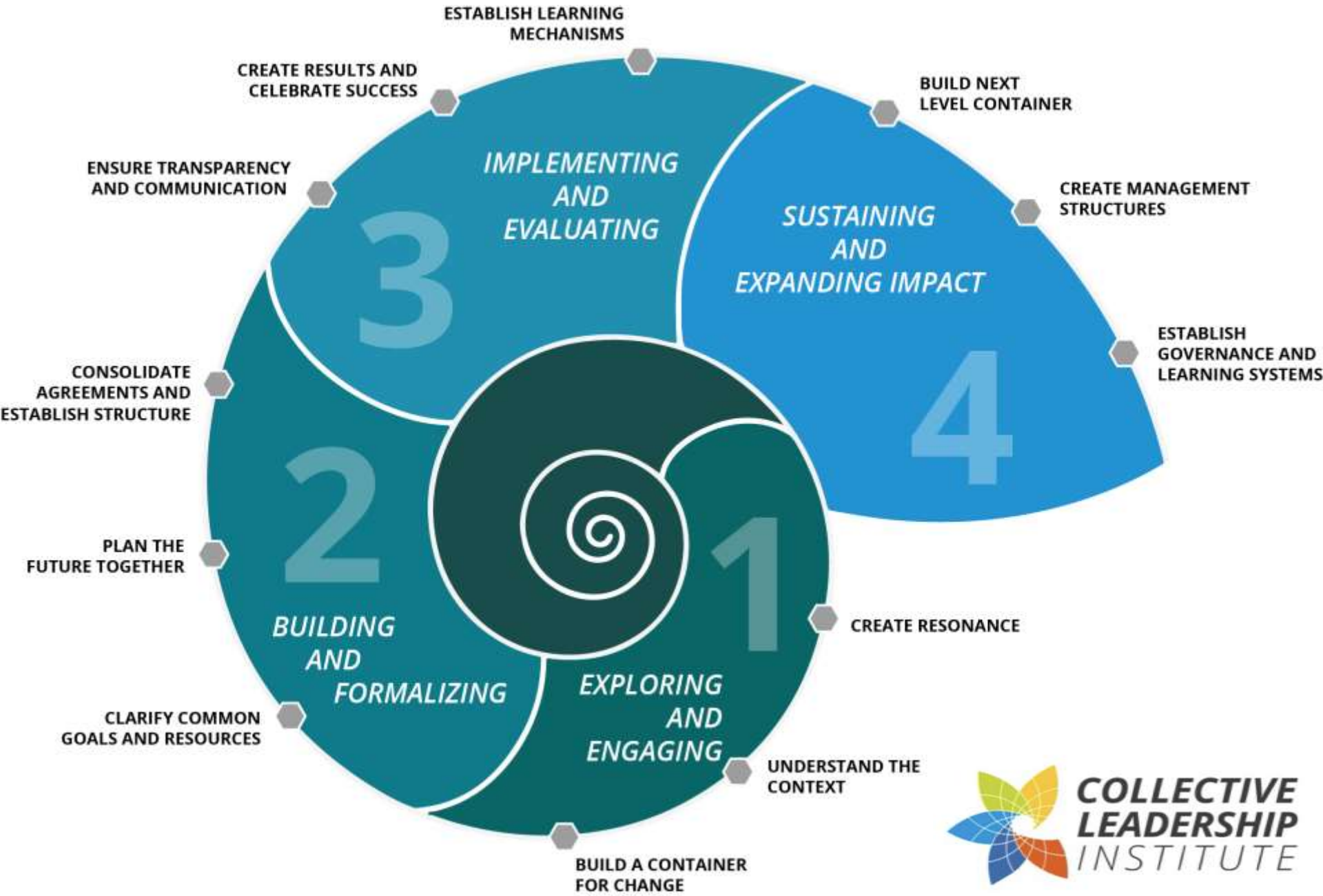

EXAMPLE 1: Bottom-up dialogic change and collaboration

Germany: District of Feldheim in Brandenburg

- Decentralized renewable energy supply for companies, private households and municipalities
- The success of this project is the good and partnership-based cooperation between the city of Treuenbrietzen, the residents of the district, the agricultural cooperative Fläming e.G. and the project developer Energiequelle GmbH.

EXAMPLE 2: Dialogue Platform for structural transformation

Eastern Ukraine: Sustainable Development of Coal Cities of the Donetsk Region

- Five coal cities in the Ukrainian-controlled part of Donbass have established a **common platform** for the pro-active shaping of their structural transformation towards renewable energy for new prospects alongside and after coal.
- These cities have recognized the decarbonisation trend in Europe and want to make structural change pro-actively
- Their focus is on innovation, new industries and technologies, energy efficiency, environmental protection, infrastructure and social stability.

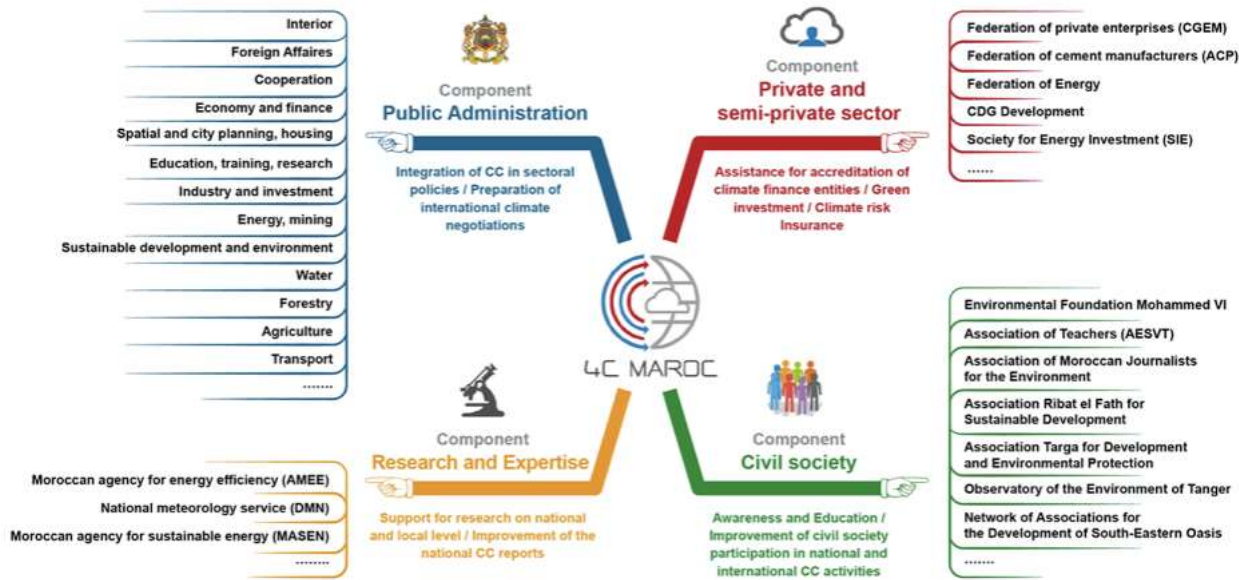

EXAMPLE 3: Cross-sector cooperation for climate adaptation/mitigation

Morocco: Climate Change Competence Centre

- Mobilization of technical expertise at national and international levels
- Developing adaptation and mitigation tools and methods adapted to national and local contexts (MRV systems / ACC indicators).
- Support to the preparation of Intended Nationally Determined Contributions (INDC)
- Setting up of a National Inventory System of institutionalized GHG (NIS-GHG), and definition of the National Inventory Unit (NIU) missions.
- Sector study on adaptation governance for the purpose of developing National Adaptation Plan in Morocco.
